

Research Poster Competition - \$1000 CAD Prize!!

The World Congress of Chiropractic Students (WCCS) is delighted to Research Posters Competition for the 2017 Annual General Meeting (AGM). This year the first place prize is being sponsored by the National Board of Chiroptic **Examiners** (NBCE). All WCCS members participating to the 2017 AGM interested in this competition are invited to submit abstracts describing their chiropractic research http://www.wccsworldwide.org/pr oposalsdiscussion-topics-2017agm.html.

The poster abstracts (max 250 words) should include: objective, methods, results, and conclusion. Students are welcome to submit their thesis project as part of this competition.

POSTER PRESENTATIONS:

Poster presenters will bring a printed poster of their research to be displayed on poster boards throughout the AGM. Poster presenters will be asked to stand by their poster to answer questions about their research during designated break times during the conference. Experimental studies involving human subjects (eg. comparative trials, pilot studies, cohort studies, and surveys) must have IRB/ethics board approval or exemption as determined by the author's institution. There are no specific measurements for the poster, but it has to be easily

readable (minimum 24"x36" – 61x91cm)

SUBMISSIONS INFORMATION

- 1. **Abstracts**: Abstracts must be written in English and are limited to 250 words maximum (word count does not include title, authors or affiliations). Do not include: references, tables, graphs, figures, pictures, video, etc. A work is eligible if it has been presented at another meeting or if it has been published, or will be published, by the time of the conference in July 2017.
- Author responsibilities: 2. Authors are responsible to check for accuracy at the time of abstract submission. Abstracts will published as submitted by the corresponding author. It is the responsibility of the primary author to ensure that all requirements are met. The primary author will be the contact person responsible for submission of all required materials and all correspondence. authors are allowed to present their material at the conference.
- 3. Attendance: For all abstracts accepted to the conference, presenting authors must be registered by July 1st 2017 to be included in the program and proceedings.
- 4. Acceptance Process: All submissions will be evaluated for completeness, strength of

contribution, and relevance to the chiropractic profession by the WCCS Board of Directors. All submission must respect the purpose and values of the WCCS. Notification of acceptance will be sent to primary authors within a month after the abstract is sent.

EVALUATION AND PRIZE

The evaluation of the poster will be made by an unbiased panel to be defined.

The prize for the best poster is of 1000CAD. The winner will be announced at the Gala Dinner.Over

National Board of Chiropractic Examiners

January 27th and 28th we (Emily Styer, Life University and Timothy Saltys, Life Chiropractic College West) had the pleasure and honor of representing the World Congress of Chiropractic Students at the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners' (NBCE) Student Leadership Forum. The forum's

intention was to allow for more transparency of the workings, goals and vision of the NBCE towards the students that it serves - and it delivered! There were an additional six students in attendance, with two representatives from each of the following associations: the Student American Black Chiropractic Association, the Student American Chiropractic Association and the 2016 NBCE Scholarship winners.

The first day of business on the Friday could not have got off to a better start with it being everybody's first time at the NBCE, it was incredible to witness the view of the Rocky Mountains in the not so far distance. After being greeted by the NBCE team, the presentations began. We learned about the structure and role of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing boards and as well as the NBCE, the history of the NBCE and how it brought about standardized testing across the US for the Chiropractic profession. Detailed presentations were given on all the resources that go into creating, pricing, administering and scoring each of the parts of the **NBCF** examinations. lt fascinating to hear how the NBCE was the first of its kind among health professions to implement a national standardized practical test of the caliber of Part IV. It set a new standard for other professions to follow. The end of the business day allowed the attendees to truly connect and engage with the staff members by interacting in a focus group/Q&A panel in which we

believe much progress was made by had earnest discussions on multiple topics from concerns over past computer-based testing administrations to confusion over what the examination scores really mean to pricing of the examinations.

On the second day we were introduced to the International Board of Chiropractic Examiners (IBCE). The IBCE is laying the foundation for standardized testing around the world. Its purpose is not only to test Chiropractors who graduated from a Chiropractic college outside of the US to see if they meet NBCE standards, but to also help other nations establish their own testing, as they seek to gain their government's recognition of Chiropractic as a health care profession. A couple of languages that the IBCE has translated its tests into for use abroad includes Korean, Japanese and Portuguese.

At the end of Saturday's business session we were greeted by a guest speaker - Dr. Tim Ray. Dr. Ray has made a name for himself in the field of sports Chiropractic and most notably for his work with athletes at multiple Olympic Games over the decades, across the globe. He detailed exactly how the International Federation of Sports Chiropractic (FICS) fits into Sports Accord, the umbrella organization all for international sports organizations. Dr. Ray shared many stories of his successes as well as failures, and gave a very honest notion to what it means to be a sports Chiropractor - turns out it is not always as glamorous as it is

made out to be. Nonetheless, in his mind it is worth every moment as there is nothing that connects people and breaks down barriers more than sports. Plus, athletes love Chiropractors for the incredible hands on, relevant, results driven care they have to offer!

Washington DC 2017 WFC/ACA/ACC

NCLC wasn't enough, this year the ACA also hosted the bi-annual meeting of the World Federation of Chiropractic (WFC) and a meeting of the Association of Chiropractic Colleges (ACC). The WCCS had an opportunity to speak to the international advisors of the International Board of Chiropractic Examiners (IBCE) and to work with the ICRS on topics like international mobility, worldwide regulation, and accreditation. The IBCE is now helping some countries set up their own board exams, which chiropractors can then use to help push regulation and integration for chiropractic in those counties.

Our next international event will be the World Health Assembly, where 4 of our members will be able to attend as delegates of the WFC. We would like to thank the WFC for their continued support of the WCCS!
